## LAST PERSON STANDING ACTIVITY

During this activity, which is used weekly to fortnightly, one student from each learning team will move to make a line at the front of the class. Students are asked outline one (1) possible response of many from a section of the syllabus. Students will answer in turn until someone either repeats an answer or cannot think of an answer. For example, students may be asked to name the groups experiencing inequalities in our society. Starting with any student, one (1) answer will be given such as overseas born. The next student will answer with another group such as ATSI and so on. The last person standing will be awarded a merit and points for their team.

Besides syllabus points, general categories can also be used to create more enjoyment from the activity. For example:

Students also will enjoy questions where a correct answer is dependent on the subjective opinion of the teacher. For example, students might be asked to give typical dog names. An answer of Rover would be good, whereas Whiskas might not. Other examples below:
